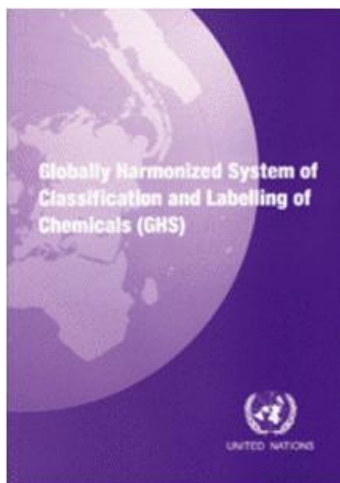

### **Are you ready for these deadlines?**

**2010-12-01 – European Union:** All chemical substances must be re-classified in accordance with the CLP Regulation.

**2011-01-01 – Singapore:** Chemical manufacturers must implement SS 586 classifications, labels and MSDS requirements for all substances.

**2011-06-30 – South Korea:** Toxic substances must comply with GHS.

**2012-12-01 – European Union:** End of transition period for chemical substances already on the market before 1 December 2010, to be relabeled and repackaged in compliance with the CLP Regulation.
